Activity 1: Making a Herbarium

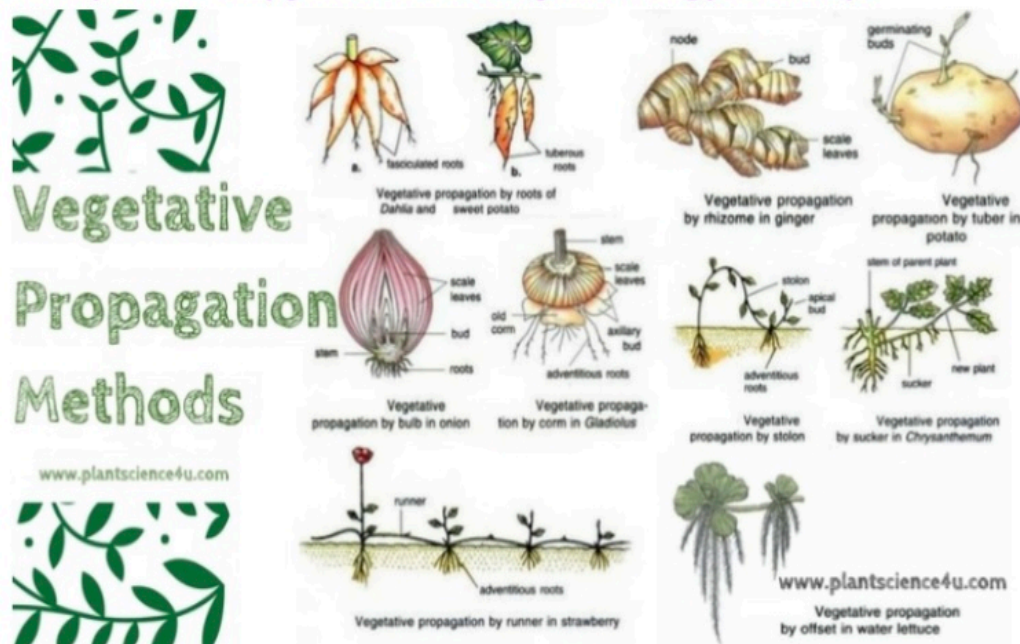
A herbarium is a collection of dried and pressed plants or leaves. For hundreds of years scientist and plant lovers have preserved dried plants for study in herbarium to use the data associated with it for scientific study.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Collect 10 leaves of different plants.
- Clean off any dirt or bugs from the plants.
- Dry the leaves by placing them in between the pages.
- You can dry all the leaves in the same book by spacing them several pages apart.
- Set it aside for 8 to 10 days to get the leaves dry.
- Once the leaves are dry you are ready to compile your herbarium pages.
- Using narrow pieces of tape secure each leaf on an A4 size sheet.
- Write the following details of each leaf:-
 - a) S.no.
 - b) Common name of the plant
 - c) Scientific name of the plant
 - d) Nutritional/medicinal quality

Activity 2: Grow baby plants from seedless plants during your holidays.

You will be amazed to know that the top section of a few vegetables like carrot, turnip, onion and potato (some of these vegetables are available in summer season) can be used to grow new baby plants. Follow these easy steps:

- Put the top of the vegetables the ones you get easily at a vegetable store near your house in a deep this leaving some space between them.
- Pour water into the dish till the vegetable crops are covered by water.
- Add some water every day to maintain the water level.

After 10 days you will observe little seedlings coming out of the vegetable tops. Plant them in different pots. Watch the plants grow and take good care of these plants during your holidays. Click picture of the plants paste these pictures in the same folder you made herbarium.
